

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE






<u>PROJECT NO. – 2</u> <u>ORIENTATION</u>

Orientation is mainly useful to enhance the bonding and to discuss about the future project that has to be done in the mere future. This includes a motivational talk and minutes speech.


